## Alternate Text for Testlet Images

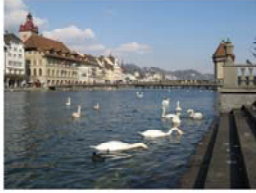
The following pages are needed **ONLY** when administering the testlet to a student who receives the **human read aloud** support and who requires **verbal descriptions of images in addition to the text**.

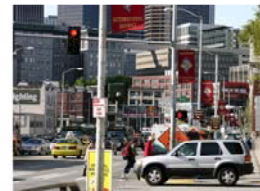
