KITE Client Installation Guide $For iPad^{\mathbb{R}}$

The Kansas Interactive Testing Engine[®] (KITETM) Client (or Test Delivery Engine) is the software that students use to take tests. When running, KITE covers the full screen of the hardware, preventing students from accessing outside information during the test. This installation sheet is for the people responsible for installing the KITE Client on each desktop computer, laptop, or tablet before students take tests.

Using the KITE Client App for iPad[®]

The KITE Client can be accessed on the iPad via an app downloaded from the App StoreSM. You will need to enable Guided Access[®] (a feature of iOS[®]) to secure each iPad during testing.

Downloading the KITE Client App

The KITE Client App is available for download from the App Store. Download and install the KITE Client app on each iPad you will use for testing.

Enabling Guided Access

Guided Access is a feature of iOS that allows only one app to run so that other software cannot be accessed.



To turn on Guided Access, perform the following steps.

- 1. Tap Settings.
- 2. On the Settings screen, tap General.
- 3. Tap Accessibility.
- 4. Tap Guided Access.
- 5. Tap the button to the right of Guided Access.

6. To set a passcode, tap Set Passcode.

- 7. Use the keypad to type a passcode.
- 8. Type your passcode a second time.
 9. Close Settings.

Setting Up the App

When you first open the KITE Client app, you can access help information, set the address for a LCS, and finish enabling Guided Access.

To set up the app, perform the following steps.

1. Tap the KITE icon.



2. On the main screen, you can access help or the LCS settings in the lower right.



Setting the LCS Address

3. Tap Save.

Finish Enabling Guided Access

- 1. To finish enabling Guided Access, triple-click the Home button.
- 2. Enter the Guided Access passcode.
- 3. At the bottom of the screen, make changes to the settings using the table below for reference.

Option	Recommended Setting	Notes
Sleep/Wake Button	OFF	Disable the sleep/wake button.
		Hint: Tap Hardware Buttons to locate this setting.
Volume Buttons	OFF	Disable the volume buttons.
		Hint: Tap Hardware Buttons to locate this setting.
Touch	ON	Enable the touch controls.
Motion	OFF	Disable the response to motion.

4. When you are finished changing settings, tap Resume at the upper right side of the screen.

Starting KITE

1. To start the KITE Client app, tap Get Started.



2. On the login screen, students enter their login ID and password to take a test.

Ending a Test Session

Note: When a student is finished taking a test, they should log out of KITE by tapping the Sign Out button.



- 1. When the Sign In screen displays, triple-click the home button.
- 2. Enter the Guided Access passcode.
- 3. Tap the End button in the upper left.

Note: The Sign In screen will reappear with a warning that Guided Access is turned off.

- 4. Click the home button to close the app.
- 5. Double-click the home button to enter multi-tasking mode.
- 6. Swipe up on the KITE Client app to fully close the app.
