

New Jersey DLM 2017-2018 Irregularity Report Form
Use to Report a Significant Testing Irregularity and/or Test Security Breach

Instructions for the Assessment Coordinator:

This form is completed by the Assessment Coordinator with the assistance of the test administrator if necessary. Keep a copy of this completed form, give one to your Chief School Administrator, and email the form to assessment@doe.state.nj.us.

- **Security Breach: Complete and submit form without delay. NJ DLM training materials and test security agreements detail security breach identifications.**
- **Other Testing Irregularities: Complete and submit form within one week when reporting a significant test administration issue.**
 - Test administration issues include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - Missing testlet components such as missing item responses, missing graphics, etc.;
 - Missing accessibility features selected in the AP, for example magnification not present (after verifying that the student's accessibility profile was marked correctly);
 - DLM technology issues not related to district technology/internet failure;
 - Use of incorrect student login ID;
 - Failure to provide manipulatives or objects when test requirement;
 - School/District emergency resulting in test session left open and/or device left unattended
 - **Do Not Report** issues related to schedule changes; taking breaks during testing due to student fatigue/behavior; district technology issues; substituting manipulatives; changing test administrators; student absenteeism resulting in late or incomplete testing due to close of test window; etc.
