

Teacher Experience for the Teacher Survey

The annual spring Teacher Survey is an essential part of data collection in support of the Dynamic Learning Maps[®] (DLM[®]) alternate assessments. Results from the survey are used to document the quality of the assessment system and to drive future improvements. Individual responses are confidential, with results only reported for groups of respondents. As a teacher who administers this assessment, you will likely receive one survey per student.

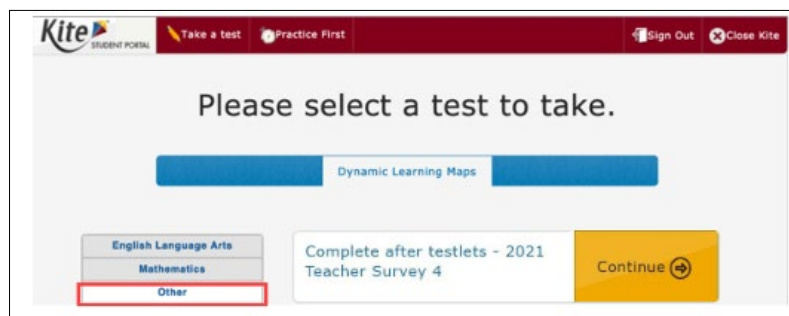
Participation in completion of the Teacher Survey is voluntary, but highly recommended.

Access to the Teacher Survey

The Teacher Survey is completed in Kite[®] Student Portal and will be available when the students log in to take their first testlet. Each student's username and password are the same for all testlets in all subjects and for the Teacher Survey. See the EDUCATOR PORTAL USER GUIDE for directions on how to access your student's credentials.

The Teacher Survey is located under the **Other** tab in Student Portal (Figure 1).

When answering the survey questions, your responses should be relevant to both you and your student's testing experience. Therefore, test administrators should administer testlets in each subject before opening the survey. If the survey is opened too soon, the test administrator can select **EXIT DOES NOT SAVE** to return to the Student Portal home page. No entries in the survey will be saved, and the test administrator can begin the survey again when the testing is completed for the student.


Once the survey is opened, the test administrator will see information about the four parts of the survey (Figure 2).

This teacher survey includes four parts. **You may stop participating at any time.**

- The first part includes items about this student's experience.
- The second part is a randomly assigned section to obtain more detailed information about a specific topic.
- The third part includes questions about the learning and assessment circumstances unique to this year.
- The fourth part is about your experience. If you have previously completed for another student you may skip.
